Itinerary

Thursday, Aug. 2 @ 3PM - Parent's drop off youth at Camp Tejas 1038 Pvt Rd 2191, Giddings, TX 78942

Sunday, Aug 5: Students will be bussed back to True Life. Parents pick up at 11 AM.

What to Bring

- Large plastic water bottle (write your name on it with a sharpie)
- Bible
- Notebook
- Pen/Pencils
- Sunscreen/Mosquito repellent
- 3-5 sets of activewear (think rock climbing wall, gaga ball, mud pit, etc)
- Clothes for indoor evening services
- Bathing suit (church appropriate; girls – one piece or colored shirt over swimsuit)
- Light sweater/jacket
- Tennis shoes
- Flip flops and/or swim shoes
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant) Do NOT bring shaving cream. Camp Tejas does not allow shaving cream at their facilities.
- Towel
- Pillow, blanket and sleeping bag or sheets for twin bed.
- Spending money for gift shop/snack bar if desired
- Personal snacks if you want them
- Prescriptions and over the counter medications need to be checked in with camp nurse upon arrival at camp.

Registration

All students entering 6th grade this fall through 12th grade (including 2018 graduates) are invited to summer camp. The cost of camp is \$279/camper. Cost includes lodging, camp meals, and transportation home from camp.

Other Requirements:

- Fill out and sign Camp Tejas Release Form (available online at above link)
- Read all Camp Rules & Guidelines
- Fill out and sign Momentum Youth Medical/Media Release Form at end of this document.
- All money and forms MUST be turned into Heather Miller by 7/11/18 in order to attend.

Payments

- Payments are accepted in the form of cash or checks made out to True Life Fellowship. You can also pay by credit card at <https://www.trueliferr.org/give>. Choose "Sponsor a student".
- If doing Momentum Fundraising:
 - June 6: \$50 deposit due
 - June 27: Remaining balance will be calculated and sent out
 - July 11: Remaining balance due (must have a total of \$279 from monies paid and raised)
- If not doing Momentum Fundraising:
 - June 6: \$50 deposit due
 - June 27: \$100 payment due
 - July 11: \$129 final payment due

If you have any questions or concerns about payments, please contact us. We want to make sure every student who wants to come to camp this year is able to come.

Personal Conduct & Courtesy

Camp Tejas & Momentum rules prohibit the use of alcohol or tobacco in any form. Additionally, conduct unbecoming a Christian which includes irreverence, disturbance of services, immodest dress, and/or use of profanity will not be tolerated. Weapons of any kind, skateboards, and rollerblades are prohibited. Do not tamper with camp equipment. Public display of affection (PDA) is not allowed. Violence of any kind will result in being sent home and suspension from the next trip/event. **Shaving cream is not allowed at Camp Tejas.**

Camp Dress Policy

Let modesty be your guide when choosing clothes to pack for camp. Guys and girls are to dress appropriately at all times. If clothing is deemed inappropriate or revealing, you will be required to change. Please make sure you are wearing protective footwear at all times.

Swimming

Swimming will be at scheduled times only. Don't climb over the pool fence. When the pool is open the lifeguard has the authority to have uncooperative persons leave the swimming pool area. Do not go to the lake until directed by a Momentum leader. The lake is off limits any other time of the day or night. Both campers and sponsors must follow all safety rules when participating in lake activities. Both girls and guys must wear T-shirts and shoes to all swimming areas. Girls wearing a two-piece swimsuit or a one piece with large areas cut out MUST have a dark colored T-shirt on at all times, even in the water. Girls are highly suggested to wear one-piece suits.

Leaving Campgrounds

Insurance prohibits anyone from leaving the camp grounds except in an emergency. Permission to leave the grounds early must be secured from the Camp Director. If you are coming late or being picked up early please have your parent contact Matt or Heather so we can plan accordingly.

Schedule

Scheduled activities are not optional unless specified on official schedule. Everyone is expected to attend the scheduled services and recreation times unless you have permission from a Momentum leader to sit out. Cabins will remain empty during all scheduled activities. Each activity starts at the printed time. Do not wait until printed time to leave your cabin. Do not return to your cabin during scheduled activities without consulting with a Momentum leader. Students are NOT allowed for any reason to be in the cabin of someone of the opposite gender or alone with anyone of the opposite gender. All students MUST be in a group of at least 3 at all times.

Camp Housing

Campers agree to pay for all damages made to any Camp Tejas property. You will be responsible to cover damages before you depart. All buildings and grounds must be left clean. Do not remove anything from the campgrounds or buildings.

Electronic Devices

Campers are ONLY allowed to bring cell phones and iPods/MP3s. Momentum leaders may confiscate these devices from students for the duration of the camp if they are becoming a distraction. Campers are responsible for their personal items. Remember, we are at camp to fellowship with each other and focus on Christ.

Curfew

Lights must be out according to camp schedule unless otherwise indicated. No one is permitted outside of the cabins after lights out. This rule will be strictly enforced and any campers outside their cabin after lights out may be sent home.

Medication, Insurance, and Liability

All campers MUST have a liability and release form on file with Momentum before attending camp. These forms will also be kept on file with the staff at Tejas throughout the duration of #ownit. All medication MUST be turned into a leader/nurse at camp. No one is allowed to keep any medication on them.

These policies have been established by Camp Tejas & Momentum Youth. Lack of cooperation with the camp policies may result in a camper returning home early at parent's expense. Depending upon the seriousness of the infraction, students may lose the ability to participate in future Momentum activities, services and/or events.
